Nuclear Cardiology - Is it all in the numbers?

Presented by Associate Professor Nathan Better Clinical Cardiologist & Deputy Director of Nuclear Medicine, Royal Melbourne Hospital and Nuclear Medicine Physician, Nuclear Cardiology, Cabrini Health

Associate Professor Nathan Better trained in internal medicine and cardiology at the Austin Hospital in Melbourne and then completed nuclear medicine training at the Repatriation Hospital and Alfred Hospital. Following this, he undertook a Fellowship program at Harvard Medical School based at the Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston, U.S.A.

Since returning in 1994, A/Prof Better has based his clinical private cardiology practice at Cabrini Hospital in Melbourne. In 1996, he set up the Nuclear Cardiology service at Cabrini and continues to work there as a nuclear medicine physician in Nuclear Cardiology and General Nuclear Medicine.

A/Prof Better also works at the Royal Melbourne Hospital as a clinical cardiologist and is the Deputy Director of Nuclear Medicine. He is involved in the full range of nuclear medicine procedures. He has completed training in cardiac CT and in 2007 helped set up that facility at Royal Melbourne, where he remains actively involved in the service.
