SELECTION INTO THE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

- ❖ To gain an internship position, you **MUST** use the PMCV Computer Matching Service
 - Register for the computer match 15-29 October at <http://computermatching.pmcv.com.au>
- ❖ Applications
 - Send an application to each cluster before 29 October
- ❖ Interviews
 - All cluster interviews within the one venue at St Vincent's Hospital on Mon 17, Tues 18 and Wed 19 November
- ❖ Final Candidate Priority List for the PMCV by 2 December
 - It is recommended that you list every cluster
- ❖ Match results
 - Available 12 December on-line at <http://computermatching.pmcv.com.au>

EMPLOYMENT

- ❖ You must be available to accept an employment offer within one week of the match results or the offer may be withdrawn
- ❖ Commencement date: Mon 12 Jan 2015. End date: Fri 8 Jan 2016
- ❖ Your employment contract will be with your cluster host site
 - Industrial award employment conditions
 - Salary packaging is available in all clusters
 - Professional indemnity insurance provided by host site
- ❖ Registration with the Medical Radiation Practice Board of Australia
 - You **MUST** hold provisional registration before commencing employment. <http://www.medicalradiationpracticeboard.gov.au/>

- ❖ You will be exempt from holding a radiation use licence in Victoria because you will be working under supervision

SUPERVISED PRACTICE PROGRAM

- ❖ You will participate in the MRPBA supervised practice program
- ❖ The MRPBA *Professional Capabilities for medical radiation practice* will guide the program
- ❖ Experience in general nuclear medicine, paediatric nuclear medicine, PET, CT, and other health areas will be provided by rotations within your cluster and others as necessary
- ❖ A nominated intern supervisor at each workplace will be responsible for coordinating your program, providing feedback and performing regular assessments

EDUCATION PROGRAM

- ❖ Interns are released from their workplaces approximately one day per month to attend the Education Program, held at St Vincent's Hospital
- ❖ The all-day sessions include skills training, workshops, tutorials, lectures, etc
- ❖ Each intern will present one talk during the year to the other interns

CLINICAL EDUCATORS

- ❖ Two clinical educators, based at St Vincent's Hospital, coordinate the internship program, provide support to interns and supervisors, visit the workplaces each quarter, and run the education program
