The Victorian Medical Radiation Practitioners Education Trust (VMPRET) is a Trust that was established on 21 June 2013. This Education Trust holds funds for the purposes of advancing the education of both practitioners and students who reside in Victoria. This Trust has been designed to support programs and research which assist radiographers, radiation therapists, and nuclear medicine technologists to further develop themselves and improve their ability to practice.

Over the eight years that this Trust has been operational, funds have been provided for a variety of projects including funding in support of course work education programs/ research as part of a research higher degree or workplace projects from medical radiation practitioners and medical radiation students based in Victoria.
