Program

The course is delivered over 16 weeks and comprises three study Modules that cover (1) the Physics of CT Imaging and Dosimetry, (2) CT Clinical Methods and (3) CT Clinical Applications. Modules 1 and 2 are studied online, and Module 3 comprises three weeks of supervised CT clinical practice.

Benefits

Nuclear Medicine Technologists/Scientists who successfully complete the course are eligible for a Radiation Use Licence to perform diagnostic CT in Victoria (DHHS health.vic) and New South Wales (EPA).
